The Berlin Airlift, At the end of the Second World War, U.S., British, and Soviet military forces divided and occupied Germany. Also divided into East and West Berlin. Surviving a normally harsh German winter, the airlift carried over two million tons of supplies in 230,000 flights. The blockade of Berlin was finally lifted by the Soviets in May 1949. Beginning in April 1949, the USSR blocked Western Allies' access to Berlin as a means of protesting the introduction of the Deutschmark in West Berlin. The division of Germany after World War II into four occupation zones, with Berlin buried deep within the Russian sector, was not a happy one. The Soviets. The Berlin Airlift was an Allied air campaign in which critical supplies were delivered to the free sector of Berlin, circumventing a Soviet blockade.
