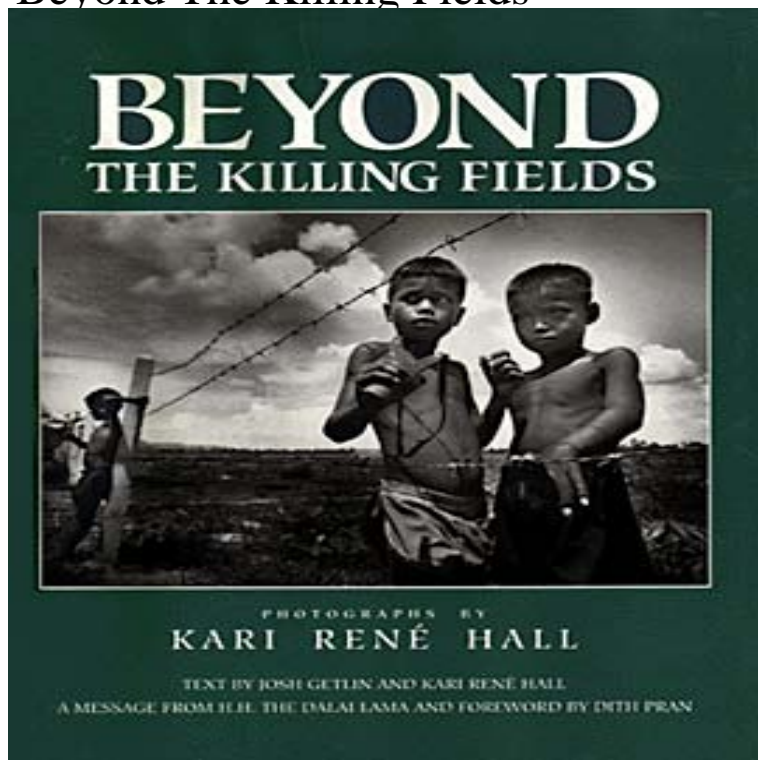


Beyond The Killing Fields
